Drawing comparisons to iconic animated films such as Yellow Submarine and the films of Hayao Miyazaki, as well as classic children's stories Alice in Wonderland and The Wizard of Oz, this fantastical dive into the world of dreams and imagination is a treat for the senses.

Sisters Juliette and Carmen's love for reading fantasy books takes on a whole new dimension when they fall into their favourite novel, *Sirocco and The Kingdom of the Winds*. Now transformed into humanoid cats, the sisters are quickly separated in this new land, which features flying divas, technicolour dragons, and other mind-melting creations, including the mysterious blue-haired wizard Sirocco, who can control the winds. While Juliette and Carmen must figure out how to reunite and escape back into the real world, they find it harder than they imagined to leave their new magical world and curious friends.

#### It's cold outside, so celebrate Christmas in July with this cosy and heartwarming film about community, friendship and family.

It's ten days before Christmas, World War II has just ended, and 10-year-old Stine has run away from boarding school and stowed away on a train. She finds herself in a small town and, seeking shelter from the cold winter night, she sneaks into a house on Cobbler Street. The house is owned by Shoemaker Andersen, a grumpy old recluse who cherishes his solitude and has no intention of spending Christmas in the company of a funny, mischievous girl like Stine. However, as much as Andersen resists being won over by Stine, she slowly melts the ice around his heart, and their encounter with each other ends up taking both of their lives in a new direction.
