While some of the films showing had previously screened here in Australia at CHIFF 2024, I also made plenty of new discoveries that I am excited to present to you this year. SCHLiNGEL is not the only festival I look to for inspiration. Giffoni in Italy, Amsterdam in the Netherlands and New York City are just some of the places where festivals dedicated to programming films for young children are held. However, here in Australia there is only one such festival, and it's CHIFF!

This year, we welcome festival favourites the Moomins and Ernest & Celestine back for more heartwarming tales. The Elfkins of Cologne and the pirates from the long-running Norwegian franchise Captain Sabertooth also return for more exciting adventures, as well as a whole host of new stories about cats, monkeys, penguins, bats, goats, tooth fairies and mutant zombie zoo animals, plus a new retelling of the classic Bambi story.

I am particularly excited about our 40th anniversary screenings of Joe Dante's *Explorers* and Tim Burton's *Pee-wee's Big Adventure*. Both Dante and Burton are distinctive for being maverick directors who found success within the studio system, and both films are examples of how films made specifically with children in mind do not need to pander to adult audiences – films that are sincerely for children have universal appeal.

Pee-wee's Big Adventure (1985) RETRO

Before Beetlejuice, Batman and Edward Scissorhands, Tim Burton was a relatively unknown director with a background in animation, which included working at Disney. Paul Reubens was a comedian whose childlike character Pee-wee Herman had appeared in a popular HBO special, and would go on to have his own TV show. Together, Burton and Reubens created this funny, anarchic and sweetly innocent cross-country adventure film that at times feels more like a live action cartoon.

When Pee-wee Herman's idyllic world falls apart after the theft of his red bicycle, the childlike adult sets out on a manic odyssey to recover his most valued possession.

Director Tim Burton, one of Hollywood's most eccentric filmmakers, makes his feature-film debut with this comic masterpiece. CHIFF is excited to present his singular vision for our 2025 edition, 40 years after it first premiered in cinemas.

Set across two different time periods, these stories about cycling teach important lessons about moral courage and challenging prejudices

Gino Bartali was a real-life legendary Italian cycling champion who won the Tour de France twice and the Giro d'Italia three times. Bartali used his talent and fame as the 'King of Cycling' during World War II to act as a courier for the Italian Resistance, and hid a Jewish family in his cellar.

Closer to the present day, two young rival road cyclists living in Jerusalem confront the impact of their divided society by forming a friendship and ultimately becoming teammates.

A story of friendship and sports told in two distinctive timelines, *Bartali's Bicycle* is a sensitive film aimed at older children about mutual respect and overcoming divisions.

One day, when attempting to prove himself, Thomas is injured and loses the ability to walk, but his adventures are only just beginning! He is about to be visited by a small furry creature from another dimension who allows him to visit a magical fantasy world where he might find the ability to heal himself. However, like many things in life, there are consequences for his actions, and Thomas must face an all-consuming monster created from his own shadow, which threatens to eat everything.
