This is the only festival in Australia where the films are selected exclusively with children in mind. I've long been inspired by author L. Frank Baum, who declared that he wrote *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz* (published one and a quarter centuries ago!) "solely to pleasure children of today...in which the wonderment and joy are retained and the heartaches and nightmares are left out."

With the spirit of Baum in mind, you will discover stories from all around the world at CHIFF. Stories about pirate mice, adventurous papaya seeds, superhero babies, runaway ostriches and cross-country car racing. There is magic to be found everywhere, with a giant hippo wishing to be small again, friendly monsters on camp, whale songs that protect the ocean, a boy made from spare parts and a girl who must save time. Travel through history to the Incan Empire, early 20th century Brazil and ancient China (with Tom and Jerry!)

We are particularly excited to be presenting the Australian premiere of the English-language version of the Academy Award-nominated *Little Amélie or the Character of Rain*, a special screening of the acclaimed underwater adventure *The Last Whale Rider*, and a Family Fun Day screening of Disney & Pixar's *Toy Story 5*. These special presentations join 25 other internationally acclaimed films that have screened at some of the most prestigious overseas festivals dedicated to young audiences, plus children's classics *Flight of the Navigator*, celebrating its 40th anniversary, and *Fly Away Home*, celebrating its 30th anniversary.

CHIFF presents a special screening of this acclaimed animated adventure about family, self-belief and the protection of our oceans.

Vincent, a teenage humpback whale, is the orphaned son of the last Whale Singer, whose magical song once protected the oceans. Burdened by the loss of his parents, Vincent doubts his own abilities. Téa Leoni stars in this heartwarming adventure from the producers of *Paddington* and *Spy Kids* about a boy and his very large bird.

August, a recently orphaned city kid, is dumped on a remote farm in South Africa to be cared for by distant relatives. Guarded and withdrawn, August develops a newfound sense of purpose when he discovers a large, abandoned egg. The egg soon hatches, and from it emerges Koobus, who grows to become a towering, 160-kilogram ostrich with a big heart, small brain, and a penchant for mayhem.

As their friendship takes flight, August and Koobus become inseparable and stand up for each other when threatened by bullies. But when August is forced to send Koobus away, he hatches a plan – rather than an egg – to rescue his feathered flightless friend.

Omul is a ten-year-old boy who lives in a seaside village with his parents, older brother Mikro and younger sister Kimi. Nervous and insecure, Omul lives in the shadow of Mikro, who gets to go out fishing everyday with their father, who Omul desperately wants to impress.

One day when Omul and Kimi are playing at the beach, the weather suddenly changes, and a huge wave washes the siblings out to sea. 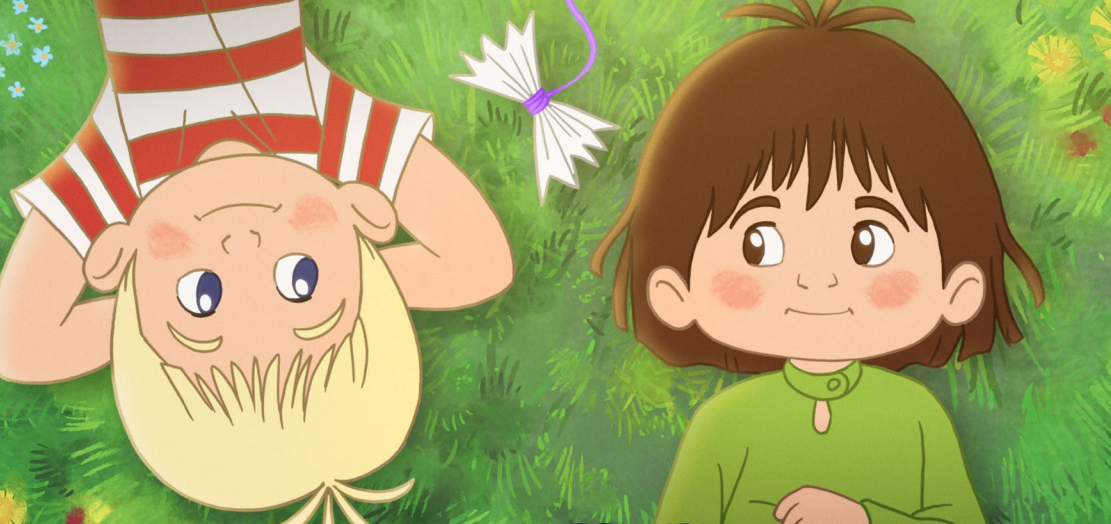

A special 40th anniversary screening of this cult 1980s family science-fiction film that combines two of the decades biggest pop culture obsessions: aliens and time travel.

One night in 1978, 12-year-old David Freeman is knocked unconscious while out in the woods. When he awakens, 8 years have passed, but he hasn't aged a bit. Meanwhile, NASA has recovered a crashed spaceship and discovered that this is somehow connected to David. David goes to the NASA research facility so they can learn more, and stumbles across the truth: he has a telepathic connection to the spaceship, and now it needs him to get back home.

Directed by Randal Kleiser (*Grease*), *Flight of the Navigator* features an all-star cast including Veronica Cartwright (*Alien*), Sarah Jessica Parker (*Footloose*) and the voice of Paul Reubens (*Pee-wee's Big Adventure*).

Be swept away by this 30th anniversary screening of the story of a father and daughter who trained a gaggle of geese to fly south for the winter, inspired by real events.

After tragedy uproots the life of 13-year-old Amy, she's forced to live with her estranged father Thomas. When she comes across a nest of goose eggs, Amy decides to raise and protect the hatchlings, bringing meaning to her life again. As geese can't be kept as pets, nor can they learn to migrate without their parents, Amy and Thomas come up with a plan so outlandish it might just work: they will use ultralight aircrafts to teach the birds to fly.

Directed by Carroll Ballard (*The Black Stallion*) and starring Academy Award winner Anna Paquin (*The Piano*) and Emmy Award winner Jeff Daniels (*The Newsroom*), *Fly Away Home* is classic, heartwarming entertainment for moviegoers young and old.

This fantastical live-action adventure stars Emmy and BAFTA-winning actor Martin Freeman and is adapted from the best-selling fantasy novel by *The Neverending Story* author Michael Ende.

Momo is a young orphan girl who lives in the ruins of an old Roman amphitheatre and has a rare gift for listening, always lending an open ear to everyone in the neighbourhood. Most of all, she loves spending time with her best friend Gino.

When a greedy and powerful corporation run by the Grey Men begin stealing people’s time to fuel their own existence, people become obsessed with productivity and efficiency and lose their joy and social connections. No one has time for Momo anymore, not even Gino! Then, a mysterious tortoise named Cassiopeia appears and leads Momo to Master Hora, the Guardian of Time. 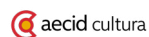

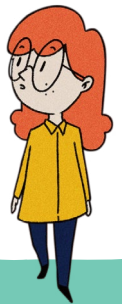
